Licking County Transit (LCT) Services is Licking County's demand responsive public transportation system providing door-to-door services to anyone in Licking County.

LCT fare in Licking County is \$4 per one-way ride or \$2 for seniors and those with special needs. One child is free with a paid adult and each additional child is \$1. All LCT vehicles are wheelchair accessible and drivers are professionally trained with

extensive background checks to meet DOT and FTA regulations.
