Guidance for how to obtain a Private Water System Permit:

- ✓ Contact a registered private water system contractor (well driller).

- Obtain a private water system permit application.

- ✓ Complete the private water system permit application. Be sure to include the private water system contractors name, ODH registration # and phone #. Complete the site plan specific to your lot and indicate your preferred well location or attach your plan if it's on a separate page.
- Return the completed application and fee to LCHD. Payment of fee can be made by credit card, cash or check. Credit card payment will also be accepted by phone.

- ✓ A site evaluation will be done by a LCHD Sanitarian to determine if the minimum isolation distance requirements have been met and if there are any other potential contamination sources.
- ✓ The private water system permit will then be issued and returned to you.
- ✓ The well must be drilled within 1 year from the date that the permit was issued.
- ✓ Final approval of the permit will be given after the contractor submits the required well log and LCHD obtains a water sample that is in compliance.
