SHOULD YOU BE USING THE TOP TETHER?

Is your child in a forward facing car seat?

Then you should be using the top tether anchor. This helps prevent whiplash and other head and neck injuries in the event of a crash.





3RD HAND SMOKE

Thirdhand smoke is a toxic residue that sticks to surfaces after smoke clears. Vapors come from clothes, furniture, carpets, walls, etc. The best way to protect your child from thirdhand smoke is to never allow smoking in your car and never let them ride in cars where smoking is allowed.

INCH TEST

This isn't the only inch test that matters this summer. Make sure your child is safe is **every** form of vehicle.

A properly installed car seat should NOT move more than 1 inch side to side or front to back.
