Ability to plan, implement, and evaluate health education programs. Bachelor's degree in Health Education, Public Health, Health Promotion, or related field preferred. Strong written and verbal communication skills required. Certified Health Education Specialist (CHES) certification preferred.

HOURS: Full Time: Monday – Friday, 8:00-4:30. Occasional evening and weekend hours.

<u>DUTIES:</u> Promotes, maintains, and improves individual and community health by assisting individuals and communities to adopt healthy behaviors. Builds and leads coalitions and collaborates with other prevention and wellness programs. May also serve as a resource to assist individuals, other professionals, or the community, and may administer fiscal resources for health education programs.
