IT'S NOT A TRICK

Seatbelts and LATCH are equally safe to use. When deciding which method to use, consider your child's weight, car compatibility, and your confidence in using that method.



MAKE SURE TO CLIP YOUR LITTLE GHOUL IN PROPERLY

The harness clip should be at arm pit level for a safe and secure fit. This also ensures that in the event of a crash, that the clip is across hard bone (like #1) and not the soft tummy (like #2).

HOW LONG TO REAR-FACE?

Children are safest rear-facing, it better protects their head, neck and spine. Keep your child rear-facing until they reach the height or weight limit of the seat.
