IS YOUR CHILD SEAT BELT READY?

By Ohio law, a child MUST be either 8 years old or 4'9" tall to ride in a vehicle without a booster seat.

While the law says 4'9" <u>OR</u> 8 years old, some children do not reach this height until years after they're 8.

Please wait until your child is **tall** enough to use a seathelt

Check the image to see if your child is tall enough to properly ride without a booster.
