Licking County Health Department is an approved provider in Ohio to administer this manager certification in food protection course. Successfully completing this course, and passing the course examination, will provide the participant with the following certificates: *ServSafe Manager Course Certificate* issued by ServSafe, and a *Manager Certification in Food Protection* issued by the Ohio Department of Health. The Ohio Uniform Food Safety Code states that all Risk Level III & IV food facilities must have one employee with supervisory and management responsibility who has obtained a Manager Certification in Food Protection Certificate.

# **COURSE DETAILS**


This course will be held at the Otterbein Granville SeniorLife Community Center (2158 Columbus Rd, Granville, OH 43023). This is a two-day course (May 21-22, 2024), and the participant must successfully attend both course dates to be eligible to take the course examination. Day one of the course is 8-5 pm, and day two is 8-5 pm. An hour is scheduled for lunch on your own for each course day (noon). A course book, examination answer sheet, and materials to take notes will be provided.

# **EXAM DETAILS**

The proctored course examination (90 multiple choice questions) will begin around 3:30 pm on the second day. The participant must receive 70% or higher on the examination to pass and receive their course certificates. If the participant does not pass the examination, they must re-take the examination at a later scheduled time.
